

2011 Fundraising

With the imposition of a new athletics fee, athletic teams at Assumption can only fundraise to finance team trips. As one goal of our program is to compete on the highest possible level, we attend high profile meets that can involve overnight travel. In order to help defray the cost of these overnight trips, it is necessary for the team to do some fundraising. Although we typically limit ourselves to 1 out-of-town meet per season, in 2011 we will be competing at 3 out-of-town meets this year: Chicago (IL), Sacramento (CA) and Cary (NC).

Run-a-thon Fundraiser (Sept 14): our primary fundraiser this season will be a 1 hour run-a-thon on Wednesday, September 14, at Seneca Park. All girls on the team are asked to participate by running for 1 hour around the perimeter of the Park. In the spirit of being one team, this will be a team-based activity where we'll ask each girl to participate by seeking out pledges from family, friends, etc. Pledges can either be based on the number of laps around the park that a girl runs in 1 hour (e.g. \$1 per lap or mile) or can be a set amount (e.g. a \$10 pledge).

For every \$30 she raises, we will provide that girl with an Assumption Cross Country shirt that denotes her role in helping fundraise money for the team. The design for that shirt is provided below.
